After leaving hospital Charlie's mummy Carrie-ann Curtis found there was very little support for herself and her family, we found this was not a isolated thing

After much needed research we found there were 32,000 bereaved parents and families in Leeds who were on a waiting list for counselling and support and 500,000 across the UK, depending on your postcode the waiting list was anything from 6months to 18months. As a family we decided to do something about this and in May 2013 we founded Charlies-Angel-Centre in March 2017 we became Charlies-Angel-Centre Foundation.

From 2013-2017 we campaign for better services for all bereaved parents and families and we developed our own services we now provide
